By-laws

Network Lake Stevens is a local group of Business Professionals dedicated to the common good of our members and the community. Our purpose is to help one another to strengthen and increase business through referrals and professional growth.

Officers –

Officers will be nominated and elected at the last meeting in March each year. They will officially fill their role April 1st of that year. The vote will be held at a meeting, and all members will be given an opportunity to vote. All officers are elected by a majority vote of the membership. If a member is not present, they may enter their vote electronically through email.

There is no limit on term for any officers.

The Board consists of:

President: Duly elected will run meetings beginning the week following the elections. The president will oversee the meetings. The President will be one of three signers on the bank accounts. The President may appoint Committee Chairs, as needed.

Vice President: Duly elected shall sit in for the President in his/her absence. The Vice-President will be one of three signers on the bank accounts.

Treasurer: Duly elected will be responsible for handling, recording and monitoring all of the organization's funds. The Treasurer will be responsible for collection of annual dues. The Treasurer will be one of the three signers on the bank accounts.

Secretary: Duly elected will be responsible for maintaining the legal documentation of the organization.

Membership Chair: Duly elected tracks membership and brings prospective applications to remaining Board for vote.

Board Meetings –

There are no scheduled Board meetings. Meetings will be called, as needed, when all elected Board members are available or the minimum of a quorum of three.

By-laws

Annual Fee of \$60 is due on April 1st of each year. If a member joins after April 1st, their membership dues will be pro-rated.

Membership can only consist of one person per industry. If a similar industry would like to join, discussion should be made with the current overlapping member before approval. If a member changes industry, they must re-apply for membership.

Visitors are invited to a maximum of two visits before they must decide if they are joining.

Attendance – If a member misses more than 3 meetings in a quarter, they are asked to send someone in their absence.

The group as a whole, can decide to remove a member to offer the spot to someone else in the industry. A vote to remove a member must be decided by a quorum of the total membership. The decision to remove a member can be because of attendance, that they no longer fit the purpose or criteria of the organization, they negatively represent the organization, or any reason that the majority of the members feel is appropriate.
